

## Fun Summer Facts


- Mosquitoes, summer's pest, have been around for more than 30 million years.

Financial Report: This months Financial Report was approved by Sara and seconded by Katy.


Bills: The Bills for the month of June were paid with approval by Sara and a second by Dan. The Moen bill is being looked at along with the Sam's Club bill.

# HARWOOD CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

*City of Harwood, North Dakota*

## Regular Meeting

July 6, 2015

**Pledge of Allegiance** recited.

**Call to Order/Roll Call.** Acting Mayor Richard Sundberg called the regular meeting to order @ 7:00 p.m. Council present: Ed Ployhart, Jennifer Spiesz and Lori Peyerl. Also present Sarah Wear, Stan Hanson, Eddie Buell, Kristian Olson, Shawna Wilson, Rolly Wall, Ron & Angie Holm, Darlene & Pete Meyer, Orville & Jo Ann Spiesz, Wade Westrick, John Westrick, Jonathan Magnell, PWS Bernie Stasch and Sherry Morris.

**Consent Agenda. Motion** by Ployhart to approve June minutes, May Financial Report and payment of July Bills/electronic transfers, *second* Peyerl. Upon roll call vote with all in favor, **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Peyerl to adjourn the regular meeting, *second* Spiesz.

Acting Mayor Sundberg called to order the Public Hearing.

**Verizon Telecommunications Facility.** Lori Peyerl reported Planning & Zoning Commission held its Public Hearing today at 6:00 p.m. resulting in no opposition and reaffirmation from the Commission that its recommendation is to approve the Conditional Use Permit for a Verizon telecommunications facility. Spiesz and Ployhart expressed concerns regarding placement asking consideration of a location more appropriate in the city's industrial area and closer to the school. Eddie Buell and Kristian Olson present on behalf of Verizon explained radio frequency engineers determined ½ mile radius that would provide maximum coverage to the north in its effort to cover the distance between Fargo and Grand Forks. The Ellingson property met its goals in the best way and zoned in compliance with Harwood's land use plan where any further south would not.

**Motion** by Peyerl to grant a Conditional Use Permit to Verizon, *second* Ployhart. Upon roll call vote, Peyerl, Ployhart, aye, Spiesz, nay. **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Ployhart to adjourn Public Hearing, *second* Spiesz.

Acting Mayor Sundberg called to order the regular council meeting.

**Driveway Request.** John Westrick asked to install a driveway from his home at 405 Truman Drive east to Chapin. It was said there was once a driveway in same location that was removed. Plans presented to Harwood Planning & Zoning Commission who recommended approval.

**Motion** by Peyerl to approve Westrick Building Permit, *second* Spiesz.

**Pre-Audit Review.** Harold Rotunda addressed the council for a pre-audit review. He warned the council the city has little reserves to cover future equipment, etc., and recommended taking a close look at debt service funds. When refinancing Street Improvement #2007-1 CD cashed from wrong fund, reversible by motion.

**Motion** by Spiesz to reapproving December, 2014 Financial and year-end financial report to reflect moving \$20,000 from Fund 322 (2007) to Fund 320, *second* Peyerl. Upon roll call vote with all in favor, **Motion** carried.

### **Water Improvement #2015-1.**

**Motion** to approve Thompson Purchase Agreement for \$233,000, one-half reimbursable from County funds, *second* Spiesz. Upon roll call vote with all in favor, **Motion** carried.

Generator, humidifier and labor will be separate bid items. Reviewed sample amortizations from Brian Osowski's letter

**Resolution Directing Assessments to be Levied.** Motion by Spiesz to direct assessments be levied and that the City Auditor notify the Chairman of the Special Assessment Commission, *second* Peyerl. Upon roll call vote with all in favor, **Motion** carried

**Motion** by Spiesz to close regular meeting and begin Public Hearing, *second*, Peyerl.

Acting Mayor Sundberg called to order the Public Hearing.

**Public Hearing - Annexation Ordinance/2<sup>nd</sup> Reading.** Notice published to annex territory encompassing the Stennes property.

**Motion** by Ployhart to approve the 2nd Reading of Annexation Ordinance to annex and include this land within the corporate limits of the City of Harwood, *second*, Spiesz. Upon roll call vote with all in favor, **Motion** carried.


